1. Data privacy statement

We care deeply about protecting your personal data. Hence, we process your personal data solely in accordance with legal provisions (GDPR, TKG (The Telecommunications Act)).

2. Data access, data storage and data security

Individuals that are in-charge of filling vacant posts have access to your saved data to the extent necessary. When using this data, these individuals ensure that data is kept confidential as defined by the prevailing valid version of the Data Protection Act (DSG).

Your data is stored in data centres that are located within the EU. Your data is protected against unauthorised access using encrypted storage and physical safeguards for the server.

3. Right to retrieve, manage, and change data, and right to revoke consent at any time

Under the EU GDPR (EU General Data Protection Regulation), personal data must be deleted once the purpose of processing it has been fulfilled. The purpose of processing data is deemed fulfilled as soon as the relevant contractual relationship ends.

We delete the relevant data when a business relationship has ended, legal provisions do not stipulate further storage of data, or if you have not consented to your personal data being processed further. You always have the right to get information about your data, to correct or delete your data, and to revoke your consent to further use your personal data according to the provisions of the prevailing valid version of the Data Protection Act (DSG).

4. Miscellaneous:

According to § 4 DSG (Data Protection Law), "personal data" means data about persons whose identity is known or can be determined. We reserve the right to amend this data privacy statement at any time with regard to the technical and legal requirements.
